# Overview:

How to express our views/ opinions and justify/ defend them in the Target Language.

# **Prime:**

Review of vocabulary, i.e. खाना पौष्टिक खाना स्वादिष्ट मसालेदार घी ≠तैल् मीठा etc. Review of Important grammatical constructions in the conversation, i.e. लगना चाहिये

## **Presentation:**

First I will express my views on this topic and make some controversial statement, i.e. "Food at Macdonald Restaurant is very good for everyone since it is cheap, full of calories and nutritious as well". I will encourage students to express their opinions on this statement in TL. When they counter my views I will say Hindi sentences, which expresses agreement and disagreement in Hindi, so students can use them later.

# **Interactive Practice:**

I will pair up the students and assign them different roles i.e. doctor and teenager, Macdonald Franchisee holder and Social worker etc.

They will be asked to show their opinions about fast-food and defend their views.

# **Accountability:**

Each student will retell what s/he learnt from their partners and say why s/he doesn't agree with him/ her.

#### Follow-up:

Each student will be asked to play a journalist's role and write a report on the conversation happened in the class about the food.
